- Title of the work.
- Brief Introduction /Background
- Statement of Problem.
- Goal and Objectives of study/ Research Questions.
- Hypotheses.
- Research Methodology
- Results
- Recommendations.
- Conclusions.

GUIDELINES FOR PREPARATION OF A POWERPOINT PRESENTATION

1. Text

- Make the text as large as possible and using same font style throughout. Exceptions are references or subtitles on graphs or pictures.
 - o Font: Arial or Times Roman (> 28 font).
 - Colors: depends upon background choices.

2. Slide

- Make each slide clear and readable.
- Total number of slide should not exceed twenty (20)
- Refer to slides using a pointer.
- Answer questions clearly and concisely; if you don't know the answer, say so.
- Time allowed for presentation is 15 minutes

3. Graphs, Diagrams, Pictures, etc.

• Make these as legible as possible.

4. Others:

- CD re-writable only should be used to copy and upload your presentation.
